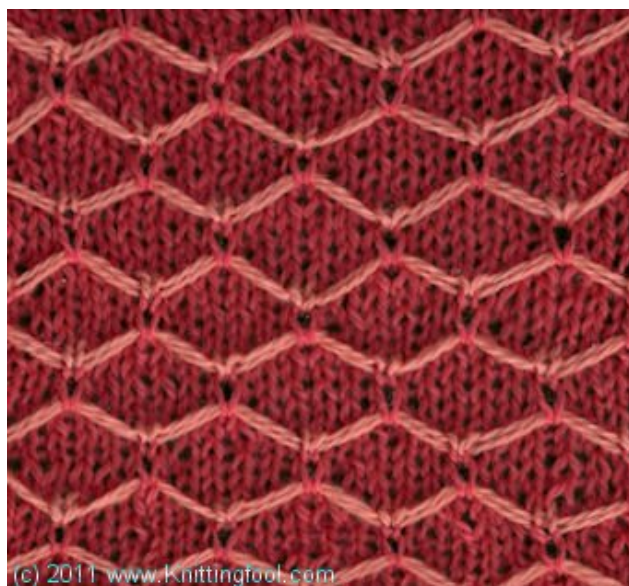


Butterfly Quilting

Multiple of 6 stitches plus 3 stitches
 Cast on with color A and purl one row
 Colors A and B

Keep the Color B strands loose as they are carried across the front of the fabric.

Row Number	Color	Begin Row	Repeat		End Row
Row: 1 - (Right side)	B	k2 *	sl 5 wyibf, k1	repeat from *	ending k1
Row: 2 -	B	p2 *	sl 5 wyib, p1	repeat from *	ending p1
Row: 3 -	A	*	Knit	repeat from *	
Row: 4 -	A	*	Purl	repeat from *	
Row: 5 -	A	k4 *	insert needle under the loose Color B strands and knit next stitch, catching both strands behind stitches as it is knitted; k5	repeat from *	ending insert needle under the loose Color B strands and knit next stitch, catching both strands behind stitches as it is knitted; k4
Row: 6 -	A	*	Purl	repeat from *	
Row: 7 -	B	k1, sl 3 wyif *	k1, sl 5 wyif	repeat from *	ending k1, sl 3 wyif,
Row: 8 -	B	p1, sl 3 wyib *	p1, sl 5 wyib	repeat from *	ending p1, sl 5 wyib, p1

Row: 9 -	A	*	Knit	repeat from *	
Row: 10 -	A	*	Purl	repeat from *	
Row: 11 -	A	k1 *	insert needle under the loose Color B strands and knit next stitch, catching both strands behind stitches as it is knitted; k5	repeat from *	ending insert needle under the loose Color B strands and knit next stitch, catching both strands behind stitches as it is knitted; k1
Row: 12 -	A	*	Purl	repeat from *	

Repeat Rows 1 - 12

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
