

Wave and Box

Multiple of 10 stitches plus 5 stitches

Work on a circular needle or a pair of double pointed needles. If worked on a circular needle, there is no need to 'sl sts to other end of needle' on even numbered rows.

Row: 1 - (Wrong side)	A	*	purl	repeat from *	
Row: 2 -	B	*	knit, then sl sts to other end of needle	repeat from *	
Row: 3 -	A	*	knit	repeat from *	
Row: 4 -	B	p1 *	sl 3 wyif, p7	repeat from *	ending sl 3, p1, then sts to other end of needle
Row: 5 -	A	*	purl	repeat from *	
Row: 6 -	B	k1 *	sl 3 wyib, k7	repeat from *	ending sl 3, k1, then sts to other end of needle
Row: 7 -	A	*	knit	repeat from *	
Row: 8 -	B	p1 *	sl 3 wyif, p7	repeat from *	ending sl 3, p1, then sts to other end of needle
Row: 9 -	A	*	purl	repeat from *	
Row: 10 -	B	*	knit, then sl sts to other end of needle	repeat from *	

Row: 11 -	A	*	knit	repeat from *	
Row: 12 -	B	p6 *	sl 3 wyif, p7	repeat from *	ending sl 3, p6, then sts to other end of needle
Row: 13 -	A	*	purl	repeat from *	
Row: 14 -	B	k6 *	sl 3 wyib, k7	repeat from *	ending sl 3, k6, then sts to other end of needle
Row: 15 -	A	*	knit	repeat from *	
Row: 16 -	B	p6 *	sl 3 wyif, p7	repeat from *	ending sl 3, p6, then sts to other end of needle
